CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

What is international credit mobility?

For over 25 years, Europe has funded the Erasmus programme, which has enabled over three million European students to spend part of their studies in another higher education institution in Europe. Erasmus+ now opens up these opportunities, allowing for mobility from and to other parts of the world (between the so-called "Programme" and "Partner Countries"). This action also supports mobility of staff (teaching or training).

Erasmus+ now offers opportunities for students to study and staff to teach or train in higher education institutions (HEIs) beyond Europe. It also makes the same opportunities available for staff and students from countries beyond Europe to come to participating HEIs in Europe. This is known as International Credit Mobility and is an activity under Key Action 1 Mobility.

How to apply

The application for students and staff is done by email. The applicant is asked to send it to <code>icmka107@uevora.pt</code>. Applicants will have to apply with a proper application form available on the following website: www.iifa.uevora.pt. All the communication with the applicant will be done by email therefore it's very important that a valid email address is presented on the application. The applicant will be asked to submit the application before the deadline of the Application Process. To the application form you have to attach the following documents: Curriculum vitae, letters of recommendation, copy of passport or other identification document, motivation letter, diplomas and certificates of qualifications, academic record, official proof of socio-economic status (if declared to have economic difficulties).

Application deadline

The application process will open **from Monday 3rd October 2016 to Tuesday 15st November 2016**. It concerns staff (academic and non-academic) and students on a total of 46 grants. Below is the table with the distribution of mobility grants for the period between January and December 2017. In the event there are still places available, a new round of applications will be open which will include a mobility period between December 1, 2017 and May 31, 2018. Selection criteria

To undergraduate and master students:

Academic merit; motivation; knowledge and interest in the host country's culture and/or language; the academic/activity plan; and the socio-economic condition of the candidates

To academic and non-academic staff and doctoral students:

Academic merit; motivation; knowledge and interest in the host country's culture; the academic/activity plan; and the socio-economic condition of the candidates, experience in previous mobility programs. They should also submit in their application, any experience of previous mobility programs and explain how your application will benefit their own research work and how it can contribute to an improvement of

procedure in your country and your institution, both in terms of teaching methods learning, whether of research methodologies, the joint research, the procedures of academic management and administration, yet both in terms of international quality assurance and cooperation.

Eligible Scientific Areas

All scientific areas are eligible however, give priority will be given to the areas of Agriculture (Agronomy, Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Engineering and Animal Science) and Spatial and Landscape Planning.
