A call for tenders is open for 2 Research Scholarships within the scope of the project "La transformación digital como estrategia de gestión del cambio hacia la PYME conectada en la region EUROACE", refa 0743\_CONECTA\_PYME\_4\_0\_4\_E", cofinanciado pelo Fundo Europeu de Desenvolvimento Regional (FEDER) através do Programa Interreg V – A España-Portugal (POCTEP), under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Management, Organization and Information Systems

**Admission requirements**: Master in the scientific area of the contest

## Preferred factors are:

- Experience in the area of organization, management and information systems and technologies;
- Experience in project management in the competition area;
- Oral and written command of portuguese and spanish and knowledge of English;
- Knowledge in the area of digital technologies;
- Knowledge in the area of information systems and document management
- Capacity for organization and autonomy

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "BI" must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.





## Work plan:

It is up to the scholarship holders to carry out research and knowledge transfer work in the area of digital transformation.

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in <a href="https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta\_Contrato\_Bolsa.docx">https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta\_Contrato\_Bolsa.docx</a>, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019 in https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt , and other applicable rules.

**Place of work**: The work will be carried out at the University of Évora – Institute for Research and Advanced Training, under the scientific guidance of Professor Dr. Jacinto Vidigal.

**Duration of the scholarship(s):** The scholarship will last for 6 months, starting in October 2021. The fellowship contracts may eventually be renewable until the end of the project.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €1.104,64, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (http://fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

**Selection methods**: The selection methods to be used will be the following: curriculum assessment with the respective valuation of: 40% academic background; 60% professional experience. As an additional selection method, if deemed necessary by the jury, or in case of a tie, a professional selection interview is applied.

**Advertising/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an alphabetically ordered list, posted in a visible and public place of the University of Évora –





Institute for Research and Advanced Training, Palácio do Vimioso, being the candidates

approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be

announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a

period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from 19th August to 2nd September 2021, and the results of the selection will be published by 17th of september

2021.

Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter with the following

documents: Curriculum Vitae, certificate of qualifications, reference or recommendation letters

and other supporting documents considered relevant.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor signed

by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of

proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this

component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution

in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of

January 25th.

The presentation of the certificate is mandatory for the signing of the contract. More
