

COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH RESEARCH CENTRE-CHRC Research Scholarship for Bachelor's degree (BI) - 1 vacancy

March 6th, 2023

A call for tenders is open for 1 (one) Bachelor's degree Scholarship (BI) in the scope of the Project SELF-CARE IN THE PERSON WITH CHRONIC DISEASE, UIDB/04923/2020, supported by national funds by the CHRC RESEARCH GRANTS 2022 through the Foundation for Science and Technology ("Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia" — FCT), under project UIDB/04923/2020, in the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Health

Admission Requirements:

- Hold a Bachelor's degree in the area of Health (e.g. nursing, medicine, psychomotor rehabilitation, other degree in the area of Health);
- Preferential factors (background in health research).

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "**BI**" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work Plan:

Activity	Objective
- Active involvement in data collection;	- To assess the self-care behavior of people with chronic diseases, in two periods in time, using instruments (questionnaires).
- Active involvement in data organization and analysis;	- To assess the quality of life of people with chronic diseases in the follow-up to World Health, in two periods, using instruments (questionnaires).
- Active collaboration in the writing and submission of articles;	- Write at least one article.

Activity	Objective
- Write a report of the work done.	- To write and submit the activities report developed during the fellowship period.

Applicable legislation: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: https://files.dre.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf and other applicable rules.

Place of work: The work will be developed at the premises of *Comprehensive Health Research Centre(CHRC)/Departamento de Enfermagem* of Évora University, under the supervision of Professor Maria do Céu Mendes Pinto Marques.

Duration: 6 months, scheduled to begin in April 2023. This type of scholarship will not be renewed.

Monthly salary: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to 930,98 €, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal ((https://www.fct.pt/wpcontent/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM 2023.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection criteria: Curriculum vitae - 100%.

Communication of the results: Results will be published, through a list sorted by final grade, posted in a visible and public place on the placard at the "Escola Superior de Enfermagem S. João de Deus". The approved candidate will be notified by email.

Under the terms of the right to a prior audience of interested candidates, the Final Classification draft will be announced by any written means to all interested candidates.

After communicating the preliminary list of evaluation results, candidates have ten working days, if they so wish, to express their positions during a preliminary hearing of interested candidates.

Application Period: This open call is available between March 10th until March 27th, 2023, and the results will be published until March 31st, 2023.

Applications must be formalized by sending an application letter with the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, certificates of qualifications, and supporting documents deemed relevant.

For application purposes, the proofs may be replaced by a declaration of honor from the candidate, but failed to demonstrate during the contractualization phase the possession of the degree required on the application until the deadline date or failure to present proof of enrollment or registration in a study cycle or course that does not confer a degree, for scholarships with this component, will result in the cancellation of the candidate's evaluation.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution according to Portuguese Decree-law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Administrative Rule no. 33/2019, of January 25th. The presentation of the certificate is mandatory for the contract signature.
