Scholarships 4 - Sines Nexus Project

A call for tenders is open for 2 Scholarships Doctoral within the scope of the project **WP1 - Nexus Open Data Collaboration Platform e WP3 - WP3 - Smart Gates e Smart Terminals**, of the Research Project named "Agenda Mobilizadora: Sines Nexus", with reference "Scholarships 4 - 5295", financed by national funds through "PRR - Plano de Recuperação e Resiliência", under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Geography, Information Systems and Technology, Geographic Information Systems, Geography and Planning, Computer Engineering or related.

Admission requirements:

Bachelor's and Master's degree in the areas of Geography, Information Systems and Technologies, Geographic Information Systems, Geography and Planning, Computer Engineering or related.

Candidates should have proven experience in the use of geographic information systems in a business or research context.

- Minimum experience of 3 years in the development of projects in the area of Geographic Information Systems;
- Knowledge of ESRI technology will be valued, namely ArcGIS API's;
- Autonomy in application development in Javascript, HTML5/CSS3, MVC .Net C#, Rest/JSON, SOAP;
- Knowledge in Python, Java Spring Framework, Node.JS, React;
- Knowledge of enterprise databases: SQL Server, Oracle, PostgreSQL;
- Knowledge of operating systems, communications and data security;
- Ability to conceptualize architectures, design and specify technical solutions;
- Ability to understand, analyze and optimize the information flows that support business needs and processes;
- Knowledge of port activity will also be valued.

They should also have experience in data processing and information systems, as well as in activities for the dissemination of scientific results and in the publication of scientific articles in indexed international journals. Mastery of the Portuguese and English languages, spoken and written, is essential.









The application package should include detailed information about the candidates' profile, with explicit reference to the candidate's experience in the areas and context indicated, namely, among others, the classification obtained in the bachelor and master degrees and, participation in projects, work and publications developed and produced previously.

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "BI" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work plan:

Participation in the definition of requirements and development of the Geo-Visualization Platform for the Open Data Platform of the NEXUS Agenda of the Port of Sines, namely:

- Analysis of available bibliography;
- Benchmarking visits to ports with experience in the area of geo-visualization (GIS component) and smart ports;
- Survey of the Port's activity and the processes that need the geo-visualization component;
- Survey of requirements and end users of the different products that need the geovisualization component;
- Collaboration in the development of a Geo-Visualization Platform for the Open Data Platform of the NEXUS Agenda
- Collaboration in the development of other Products, flexible enough to provide geovisualization capabilities both for the internal customer (other WP products that need visualization instances) and for the external customer (external users).
- Collaboration on digitizing processes through mobile applications, using a rapid development model, leveraging existing technology at the Port (namely ESRI mobile application development tools and Data Portal/webservices/visualizations). Some of the examples include asset inspection processes, meter readings (water, gas, energy, others), environmental inspections and other similar processes.
- Collaboration on developing process efficiency improvement, real-time monitoring, and inclusion of collected data into data products.

In parallel:

- Participation in national and international technical-scientific meetings.
- Support in the preparation of interim reports and collaboration in the final report
- Monitoring of the project's evaluation indicators
- Preparation of scientific papers for publication in indexed international journals
- Organization and participation in dissemination actions









Organization of workshops and seminars

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template former.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: https://files.dre.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf and other applicable rules.

Place of work: The work will be developed at IIFA - Instituto de Investigação e Formação Avançada of the University of Évora, under the scientific guidance of the Professor Maria Teresa Folgôa Batista.

Duration of the scholarship(s): The scholarship will have a duration of 12 months, starting on May of 2023. The scholarship contract may be renewed up to december of 2025 or until the end of the funding project's budget allocation.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 1 199,64, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM 2023.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be the following: Curriculum Evaluation 20 values (100%) and Interview (if necessary), in which case the valuation is 12 values (60%) for the curriculum evaluation and 8 values (40%) for the interview.

Advertising/notification of results: The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an ordered list by final grade obtained posted in a visible and public place IIFA - Instituto de Investigação e Formação Avançada, being the candidate approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from $\underline{11}$ of April to $\underline{26^{th}}$ of April of $\underline{2023}$ and the results of the selection will be published by $\underline{2^{nd}}$ of May of $\underline{2023}$.









Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter with the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, certificate of qualifications, reference or recommendation letters.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.
