A call for tenders is open for 1 Scholarship B.I. within the scope of the project “Holy Bodies | An Atlas of the Corpi Santi in Portugal”, ref: 2022.01486.PTDC, financed by national funds through Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia, OE, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Computer Science

Admission requirements:

Degree in Computer Science.

Proficient level in the Portuguese language.

As set forth in FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, articles 3 and 6, candidates for "B.I." (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of March 24 and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work plan:

The scholarship holder will develop the project's digital platform, collect and process data from various sources, and subsequently contribute to developing online tools for disseminating the project's results. The scholarship holder's work includes the following phases:

Phase 1 – Gathering requirements on data typology and volume, user profiles and information retrieval features

Phase 2 – solution's general specification

Phase 3 – Study of relevant technologies for the implementation of the distinct components of the designed solution

Phase 4 – Development, deployment and testing

Phase 5 – Software maintenance, monitoring of platform performance and user support.

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template [former.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx](https://files.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx), pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: <https://files.dre.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf> and other applicable rules.

Place of work:

The work will be developed at the Computer Science Department of the University of Évora under the scientific guidance of Prof. José Saias and Prof. Teresa Alexandra Ferreira.

Duration of the scholarship:

The scholarships will have a duration of six months, starting on October 2023.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €930.98, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_2023.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection methods to be used will be the following: curriculum evaluation and interview with the respective valuation of 50% for curriculum and 50% for interview.

Advertising/notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an alphabetically ordered list posted in a visible and public place at the Computer Science Department of University of Évora, being the candidate approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the evaluation results, candidates have 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from August 14 to September 11, 2023, and the selection results will be published by September 27, 2023.

Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter with the following documents: Curriculum Vitae and certificate of qualifications.

For the purposes of the application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honour signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25.
