Research Scholarship for Bachelor's Degree – 1 vacancy

A call for tenders is open for one Bachelor's Degree Scholarship within the scope of the project Interdisciplinary Centre for History, Culture and Societies University of Évora - CIDEHUS, UIDB/00057/2020, financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Humanities/Social Sciences

Admission requirements:

- Degree in Languages and Literatures, Linguistics, Communication, or similar areas.
- Enrolment in a master's, doctoral or non-degree course in Languages and Literatures, Linguistics, Communication or similar areas.
- Computer knowledge from the user's perspective.

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "BI" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work plan:

Project "The History of the Future, by António Vieira: Lexicon and Spelling. Following the project "The History of the Future, by António Vieira: Lexicon and annotated corpus", this project proposes:

- 1. Using the Lexicon prepared as part of the previous project, deepen the lexical study of the work.
- 2. Using the corpus annotated in the previous project, build a lexical corpus of the work
- 3. Collect and analyse the spelling variants in the work based on the conservative edition of Banza (2023, in press).







Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template former.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta Contrato Bolsa.docx, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation no950/2019 of December 16, 2019: https://files.dre.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf and other applicable rules.

Place of work: The work will be developed at the Interdisciplinary Centre for History, Culture and Societies of the University of Évora (CIDEHUS-UÉ) or online, under the scientific guidance of Professor Ana Paula Banza.

Duration of the scholarship: The scholarship will last for 6 months, starting in January 2024. The scholarship contract can be renewed, according to present regulation.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 930,98, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM 2023.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be the following: Curricular assessment (100%):

- Academic formation relevant to project area (50%)
- Relevant experience in the project area (50%)

If needed, an interview may be called, for which the following evaluation will be used.

- CV assessment (80%)
- interview (20%)

Composition of the Selection Jury:

Advertising/notification of results: The final results of the evaluation will be publicised, through an ordered list by final grade obtained posted in a visible and public place in Palácio do Vimioso, being the candidate approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.







After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from 4^{th} of December to 19^{th} of December of 2023 and the results of the selection will be published by 22^{nd} of December of 2023.

Applications must be formalized, mandatory, by sending an application letter with the following documents:

- a) Curriculum Vitae;
- b) Certificate of qualifications;
- c) Letter of motivation;
- d) Master's or PhD enrolment certificate;
- e) Other supporting documents considered relevant.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honour signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrolment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.
