Research Scholarship for Master Degree - 1 vacancy

A call for tenders is open for one Master Degree Scholarship within the scope of the project RIGHT PLAY, (2023.00119.RESTART), financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES), under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Human Kinetics

Admission requirements:

Master in Psychomotricity or other similar areas of Human Kinetics. Experience in child development promotion through body-oriented tecnhiques, as well as in research projects will be a preferencial factor.

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "**BI**" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

According to FCT Research Grants Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 5, -**BII** (Initiation to Research Grants) cannot be awarded to those who have already benefited from research grants directly or indirectly funded by FCT, awarded under the Research Fellowship Statute.

Work plan:

- Preparation and implementation of interviews with educators and preschoolers;

- Preparation and planning of a rough-and-tumble play based intervention program for preschoolers;

- Implementation and monitorring of a rough-and-tumble play based intervention program for children;

- Assessment of the impact of the intervention program on children's competencies and health indicators, and on the experiences and perceptions of educators.







- -Dataset management.
- -Data analysis.

-Participation in scientific communication and dissemination.

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template <u>former.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx</u>, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: <u>https://files.diariodarepublica.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf</u> and other applicable rules.

Place of work: The work will be developed at Comprehensive Health Research Centre of the University of Évora, under the scientific guidance of the Professor Guida Veiga.

Duration of the scholarship(s): The scholarship will have a duration of 16 months, starting on February of 2024.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 1.199,64, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (<u>https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_2023.pdf</u>), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used are as follows: curriculum evaluation (50%, fifty percent), and interview (50%, fifty percent).

Advertising/notification of results: The final evaluation results will be publicized through a list ordered by the final score posted in a visible and public place at the Comprehensive Health Research Centre of the University of Évora, and the approved candidate will be notified by email. After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.







Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from <u>22 of January to</u> <u>5 of February of 2024</u> and the results of the selection will be published by <u>9 February of 2024</u>.

Applications must be formalized, mandatorily, by sending a cover letter accompanied by the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, certificate of qualifications, proof of enrollment in a study cycle or course not leading to an academic degree, and other relevant supporting documents.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honour signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.
