Optics Specialist and Heritage Scientist. Director of Research at CNR-INO (the National Institute for Optics of the National Research Council of Italy, <http://www.cnr.it>). He started the Gruppo Beni Culturali (now Heritage Science Group) at the INO in 1998 and since then managed many research projects in the field of optical technologies applied to Cultural Heritage. Among these, the two EU Integrating Activity initiatives IPERION CH and IPERION HS (2014-2024). He started and was the first coordinator of E-RIHS, the European Research Infrastructure for Heritage Science. He was the initiator of DARIAH-IT, the Italian node of DARIAH ERIC, Digital Research Infrastructure for the Arts and Humanities, and its first National Coordinator. He directed the INO Research Unit in Lecce for 13 years. Among his research interests are: optics applied to the safeguard of Cultural Heritage; optical metrology; 3D-measuring optical techniques; optical systems design; interferometry; phase analysis techniques and software design.
