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Teaching Module to 1st Cycle Courses I (LLT9368D)

This course has two aspects, teaching and science, whose syllabus are impossible to stipulate beforehand, always depending on the framework of interests of students attending the curricular unit, which incidentally is also true in the definition of objectives learning. To define the programmatic line of the unit is necessary as to note the doctorate of interest with which it works, interests, those who are dependent on the matter on which the dissertation will focus to build. Perceived programmatic line search, it deploy it in various contents, that explore multiple aspects, usually linguistic, stylistic and theoretical, but also critical, historical and contextual.

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Thesis Project I (LLT9864D)

This Course is taught under the Tutorial Orientation so the syllabus has a malleability consistent with this situation.

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Teaching Module to 1st Cycle Courses II (LLT9370D)

It is course with a double aspect, teaching and scientific, thus the syllabus is impossible to stipulate beforehand, always depending on the framework of interests of the students attending the subject, which, incidentally, is also true in the definition of the learning objectives. The line is determined in the first semester, in compliance with the subject upon which the dissertation will be written, in the second semester it is time to develop and consolidate the various lines that exploit the multiple directions (linguistics, stylistics, theoretical, critical, historical, contextual and hermeneutical) of the main programmatic line that is dependent on the dissertation to be written, as it was referred before.

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Thesis Project II (LLT9865D)

Given the priority assigned to the development of rigorous thesis project and tutorial orientation system, the syllabus need to adapt to the specific needs of students and the respective study. However, when appropriate, we will seek give continuity to program content proposed for Project I - The Literary Theory and the studies of modern and contemporary Portuguese literature - given the relevance of it to prepare a dissertation.

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Seminar A in Literature (LLT9361D)

1. The theory of literature as a discipline. 2. Formalism to Structuralism; basis to litarality; Structuralism or the textual object; basis to semiotics. 3. Post- Structuralism. Cultural Studies.

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Seminar B in Literature (LLT9362D)

The questioning of the notion of modern and contemporary Portuguese literature. Portuguese literary phenomena in the nineteenth-century and the twentieth-century.



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Project Seminar I (LLT9363D)

1. Structure of a PhD dissertation project. 2. Building of a dissertation project, based on the work developed by the student in the curricular units of Literary Theory (Seminar A in Literature), Literary Studies (Seminar B in Literature) and papers, conferences and lectures (cycle of conferences).

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Conference Cycle (LLT9364D)

Students must attend a series of conferences (integrated or not in symposia and conferences) of scientific literature, the institution or preferably outside and internationally, established by the teaching staff of the course.

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Seminar C in Literature (LLT9365D)

I. Historical and literary perspective of the English novel in the nineteenth century; II. Jane Austen and her contemporaries; III. The domestic novel; a. The social and family relationships; b. The structures of feeling of the Regency period; IV. Jane Austen's world; V. Marriage in Jane Austen's novels
