3. Program description:

PIUDHIST is an inter-university doctoral programme in which History is viewed from an inter-disciplinary point of view. In our vision, this is also why we consider apposite to attach, as a subtitle for this programme, the words "change and continuity in a global world". As such PIUDHist is a result of formal cooperation between four Portuguese universities:

§ Universidade de Lisboa – Instituto de Ciências Sociais and Faculdade de Letras

§ ISCTE-Instituto Universitário de Lisboa – Departamento de História

§ Universidade Católica Portuguesa – Centro de Estudos de História Religiosa (Faculdade de Teologia) e Faculdade de Ciências Humanas

§ Universidade de Évora – Instituto de Investigação e Formação Avançada

The taught component of the program will take up most of the students' time during the first two semesters. The course is organized into four basic thematic axes, of which students will choose two:

§ Social dynamics and political structures

§ Institutions and economic development

§ Empires, colonialism and post-colonialism

§ Intellectual and socio-cultural movements

Students enjoy the greatest freedom in their choice of thesis topic and of thematic seminars. Guidance will be provided by the management board of the programme, to ensure that these options are relevant, sound and well-motivated, that they focus on original and appropriate source material and that, as far as possible, they include comparative and interdisciplinary components in their plan.

8. General conditions of access and admission:

i Legal conditions for access to the cycle of studies leading to the «Doutor» degree (Ph.D. degree)

The following individuals can apply for a cycle of studies to the «Doutor» degree (Ph.D. degree):

- holders of a Portuguese Mestre degree (Master degree) or legal equivalent;;
- holders of an undergraduate degree holding a specially relevant academic or scientific curriculum, which is recognized as attesting capacity to carry out this cycle by the competent scientific committee of the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted;
- holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting the ability to carry out this cycle of studies by the competent scientific committee of the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted.

ii Specific admission conditions

Students admitted to the PhD programme should meet the following criteria:

Holders of a master's degree (or the legal equivalent in terms of ECTS awarded at an intermediate graduate level) in history or in any other field of the humanities and social sciences

Exceptionally, in the terms of the Portuguese legal rules, holders of undergraduate or graduate courses whose CV and recommendation letters disclose the candidate's outstanding ability to undertake

advanced studies in history

The application to PIUDHIST should be filled-in online – Application Link – accompanied with the following documentation:

Curriculum Vitae;
Academic transcripts and legal proofs of the diplomas and degrees awarded;
Letter of intent stating the reasons and the motivations for choosing PIUDHIST;
Outline of doctoral dissertation project;
Master's dissertation and, if applicable, another relevant publication (pdf copies);
Two letters of recommendation;
and a photo.

All candidates to PIUDHIST will be subject to an initial screening procedure, in order to confirm the fulfillment of the above conditions. Candidates approved in principle will be short listed for interview, in person or via skype.

The expected number of students to admit in each edition of PIUDHIST is 15.

9. Selection Process:

- Academic qualifications: 35%
 - Classification in the Bachelor's degree: 30%
 - Classification in the Master degree: 70%
- Curriculum analysis: 35%
 - Experience and ability to develop advanced research: 100%
- Interview: 30%
 - Letter of motivation, interview and pre-project of PhD: 100%

Observations regarding the selection process:

The final decision on the ranking of applications will be communicated up to one month after the closing date of each of the application phase.

The candidates will be ranked by the Commission of the Doctoral Program.

- Tuition fee: 2750.00 €

The fee to be paid for the application is €50 (fifty euros) and there is no refund if the candidate is excluded or not selected.

Tuition fees for the academic year 2019/2020 are as follows:

- Students with scholarship and international students:
- From 1st to 4th year: 2,750 euros / academic year

- National students without a scholarship:

1st year - Benefit from a scholarship awarded by the Doctoral Program equivalent to 50% of the amount of the tuition, - 1,375 euros

2nd, 3rd and 4th years - 1,200 euros (under the scholarship awarded by the Doctoral Program)
